1. General admission requirements

Starting the master course of studies at the Rosenheim University is possible both in the winter and in the summer term. Registration deadline is January 15th (for the summer term, starting March 15th) or July 15th (for the winter term, starting October 1st).

Online application is possible via our Internetsite www.fh-rosenheim.de. By way of exception the application form can be obtained at the students administrative services office at the university. Please add only officially certified copies to the application form (not applicable in case of the |curriculum vitae| and the |application letter| forms).

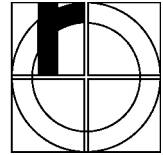
The following documents need to be presented:

- Diploma or Bachelor Certificate of the first/undergraduate course of studies (if it is not yet handed out, confirmation of the marks/grades may be used as proof of a successful pass of the first course of studies). It is essential that the cumulative mark/final grade be shown.
- If necessary, diploma supplement or transcript of records as proof of the achieved ECTS points of achievement during the first/undergraduate course of studies. Their presentation is not necessary if the ECTS points are shown in the certificate. Neither is there any proof necessary for applicants of the Rosenheim University.
- Printout of the ‚curricula vitae form‘ (is offered for download after the online application). Please complete in hand writing.
- Printout of the ‚application letter form‘ (is offered for download after the online application). Do not forget to sign it.
- If necessary proof of removal from university register
- University entrance qualification (single copy, as only for statistical purposes)

2. Special eligibility requirements

Apart from the general admission requirements listed above, special eligibility requirements for admission to the master course of studies must be fulfilled. Following you will find a list of eligibility requirements applicable for your course of studies:

Please read these requirements carefully as they are an important part of your university application.



Extract of the studies and examinations regulations:

“§ 3

Requirements of admission

(1) *Technical admission requirements for the course is the above-average degree in electrical Engineering and information technology or neighbouring subject areas at a German university or an equal degree from a foreign university.*

(2) *Above-average degree means that the performance attributes 'very good' or 'good' have been reached as the cumulative mark/final grade. Eligibility for the Masters course of studies may be also reached by a cumulative mark/final grade with the performance attribute 'satisfactory/average' if above-average performance can be shown by a relevant professional career lasting at least two years, provided a written examination is successfully passed in accordance with paragraphs 4 and 5.*

(3) *Further qualification requirement for the course of studies is the knowledge of English. Proof of the necessary level of English for the course of studies can be:*

- 1. TOEFL with 550 points or better.*
- 2. CBTOEFL with 213 points or better.*
- 3. Internet-based TOEFL with 84 points or better.*
- 4. IELTS volume/edition 6.0 or better.*
- 5. Cambridge ESOL CPE with Grade C or better.*
- 6. Cambridge ESOL C\IE with Grade C/B or better.*
- 7. A 'good' (or better) in 'Technical English' or an equivalent English subject from the former course of studies.*

Exempt from the proof of sufficient English knowledge are applicants whose mother tongue is English. If in doubt or if no relevant proof can be provided, an equivalent language test of the University of Rosenheim may have to be added to the above record of qualifications.

(4) *Decisions regarding the equivalence of foreign university degrees remain with the board of examiners for themaster course of studies in electrical engineering and information technology. In cases of doubt, the board of examiners may additionally stipulate the passing of a written examination in accordance with paragraph 5.*

(5) *Subject of the written examination in accordance with paragraph 4 are questions regarding relevant topics within the field of electrical engineering and information technology of the bachelor course of studies at the Rosenheim University. The date of examination is determined by the board of examiners. Examination duration is 90 minutes. Examiners are nominated by the board of examiners.*

(6) *In so far as applicants give proof of a completed university course of studies for which less than 210 ECTS points (but at least 180 ECTS points) were granted, the proof of having gained the missing points of achievement from the technically relevant courses offered at the Rosenheim University is required for passing the master examination. The board of examiners determines which course and examination achievements have to be taken.”*
