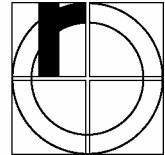
### 3.3 Access Requirements

The requirements for studying Business Administration are allgemeine Hochschulreife or Fachhochschulreife (German qualifications for admission to higher education) and completion of a six week internship in a business administrative area prior to commencing studies. This internship is not required for graduates of a Fachoberschule with a major in business economics or for applicants with a successfully completed apprenticeship in business or at least one year employment in Business Administration.

## 4. CONTENTS AND RESULTS GAINED

### 4.1 Mode of Study

## 4.2 Program Requirements

Business Administration is concerned with analysing, forming, running a business as well as with the development of the economy. The course of study is aimed at later activity in commerce.

The course of study in Business Administration takes 8 semesters. The program consists of a uniform basic studies program and specialisation in a major area. The basic studies program is completed after four semesters (three theoretical and one internship semester) Internships are to be completed in the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> semesters.

After the sixth semester the major area of study has to be decided on. Studies in the the major area are concluded with the Diploma Examination for the degree Diplom-Betriebswirt (FH) (Degree in Business Administration).
