## Practical Information

Cost of living	About 650 € – 850 € per month, including housing, meals, health insurance and personal expenses. Students may have to acquire study materials at their own cost.
Housing	Student dormitories: The Student Union offers accommodation for students at a reasonable price (about 250 €/month). A number of rooms is available for exchange students. Students note in their online application if they decide to stay in student housing (strongly recommended).
