Application procedure	
Online application system	All applications have to be submitted via an online application system called Mobility Online. Once Fontys has received your nominations, we will send the students a link to the online application form of Mobility Online.
Fall Semester	Nomination deadline: 30 April 2020 Application deadline: 15 May 2020
Spring Semester	Nomination deadline: 31 October 2021 Application deadline: 15 November 2021
Application documents	All application documents need to be uploaded in Mobility Online. Please do not send them to us via email or by post. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Copy of valid passport • Grade list • A proof of English proficiency

Language requirements	Exchange students are expected to have a good command of English. For EU students we expect a statement from the university on the student's level of English (the minimum is B2). Non-EU students are required to submit an IELTS (6.0), TOEFL iBT (80), TOEFL PBT (550) or similar certificate.
Admission and enrolment	After the application documents in Mobility Online have been approved, Fontys will issue an acceptance letter. Students will receive more information about their enrolment and the start of the programme after admission.
Practical information	
Accommodation	Fontys can arrange accommodation for exchange students. To apply for accommodation assistance through Fontys, they will need to fill out an accommodation form before the application deadline in Mobility Online.
Insurance	<p>By law everyone in Holland must be insured for medical expenses. The third party liability insurance and repatriation insurance are strongly recommended. Every student enrolled at Fontys is expected to have fulfilled his/her insurance obligations before arriving. Fontys cannot be held liable if a student does not have (sufficient) insurance cover. More information about insurances: www.fontys.edu and www.studyinholland.nl.</p> <p>If students require an entry visa and/or residence permit, insurance will form a part of the immigration procedure, which Fontys will arrange on their behalf. For further information regarding the level of cover of this insurance, please check here. They will receive more information about this insurance and the payment during the visa process.</p>
Visa and/or residence permit	<p>Students may not apply for their own entry visa and/or residence permit. Fontys has an agreement with the Dutch Immigration Service (the 'IND') and will therefore, as part of the application procedure, apply for entry visas and residence permits on behalf of its students (if applicable). The student will receive a payment letter for the visa costs (€ 174*). Besides this, the IND requires a financial proof of living expenses (€ 900* per month) before they start their studies. The student can prove this amount through bank statements but the money can also be transferred to the Fontys bank account. Both possibilities will be given to the student during the visa application procedure. More information: www.fontys.edu.</p> <p><i>*subject to change</i></p>
Nuffic Certificate	All students with Chinese nationality are required to apply for a Nuffic Certificate themselves. Students with a Hong Kong passport are exempted from this requirement. More information: www.studyinholland.nl .
Financial matters	The average living expenses per month for a foreign student in Holland are between € 900 and € 1,200 per month. These living expenses cover rent, insurance, food, public transportation, books, clothing and other general costs.
